PUBLIC COMMENT	Chair Vinyard opened the public meeting at 4:30. There was no public comment.	
! COUNSEL'S REPORT	Ross Island Sand & Gravel: Counsel is working on a license agreement for use of port roads. Need to clarify which piece of land they will use and tighten conditions for use. PC Deo feels strongly that the road needs to be paved; part of the road is already paved. Watering of the roads for dust control would have to be constant in summer months. PC Vinyard suggested we allow a trial period of maintenance; if not adequate, require pavement. Exec.D Sherwood stated that she feels RISG won't agree to paving. Discussion followed. A proposal has not yet been received from Tenneson Engineering for the cost of an initial survey of port roads. A draft agreement will be presented to RISG as soon as it's available. Crane: Counsel will begin work on an agreement with Slim's Recycling for removal of the crane.	Mark pavement end on aerial.

<u>I Annual Personal</u> <u>Financial Affairs</u> <u>Statement</u>	Exec.D Sherwood discussed the information included in the packet regarding the PC's requirement to complete their personal financial affairs statement by April 15.	

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT *Bingen Point* ! Mount Adams Loggers' Assoc. (MALA)	Exec.D Sherwood discussed the MALA property issue, stating the proposed developer is aware that there is a fire-flow issue on the property. The proposal to MALA is verbal. There would be a tax penalty if they sell their property, due to MALA's S-Corp status; they have two more years before the 10 year requirement is no longer relevant. Ray Verley will call Monday after their 1:00 Assoc. meeting to discuss the proposal. After an offer and acceptance, the port has 60 days to answer pursuant to the Port's right of first refusal. The port has access to money from CRB should the PC wish to purchase the property. PC Vinyard and Exec.D Sherwood met with Don Struck (KC Commissioner). Don is adamant that the port should acquire the property and stated he will discuss the possibility of a short term loan to the port with the other KC commissioners. Lisa Davies in Counsel's office is proficient in shoreline issues and Counsel will ask her to investigate the regulations. Counsel stated that with Google tying up the majority (30 acres plus) of Port of The Dalles' developable property, focus will shift to POK property. Matt Riley asked if the port couldn't get what it wants in exchange for relinquishing its right of first refusal. Counsel confirmed the idea. Exec.D Sherwood has discussed potential concerns and port desires with the developer. PC Ford will not be available for the March 15 meeting. Exec.D Sherwood will contact the PC after hearing the outcome of the MALA Assoc. meeting on Monday if a special meeting is needed.
<u>Insitu Rental 1/4 Acre -</u> PUD Pole	Exec.D Sherwood reported that Counsel is working on an addendum for Insitu's rental of 1/4 acre of Lot #15. They will be using the property for testing. The PUD installed a pole to simulate the mast of a tuna boat.
<u>*Dallesport Industrial</u> <u>Park* (DIP)</u> <u>I Personal Services</u> <u>Contract - Tenneson</u> <u>Engineering</u>	The Personal Services Contract with Tenneson Engineering to do site work for KC's proposed project has been given to Tenneson for signature.
