Thornsbury said there will be an election in November of 2011 for a two year term, in order to get back to the six year term cycle for the position. The PC set a deadline for accepting applications of May 18, 2010. The application will consist of a resume of experience, community involvement, references, and a statement of why they want to be a Port Commissioner.
