

Port Parks To Close For Event

Bingen, Washington – The Port of Klickitat parks located at Bingen Point will be closed on Saturday, June 23, 2018, for the "Rock the Point" event being held by the United Way of the

Columbia Gorge. In addition, use of Bingen Harbor will be limited and the anchoring of vessels in the harbor will be prohibited on that day. However, the boat ramp and boat parking area at Marina Park will remain open to the public and available for launching watercraft and accessing the Columbia River.
