RESOLUTION NO. 3-2010

A Resolution of the Port of Klickitat Commission
Appointing an Agent to Receive Claims for Damages

WHEREAS, the governing body of each local governmental entity shall, pursuant to RCW 4.96.020, appoint an agent to receive any claim for damages made under RCW 4.96; and

WHEREAS, the identity of the agent and the address where s/he may be reached during the normal business hours of the local governmental entity are public records and shall be recorded with the auditor of the county in which the entity is located pursuant to RCW 4.96.020; and

WHEREAS, all claims for damages against a local governmental entity or against its officers, employees, or volunteers acting in such capacity, shall be presented to the agent within the applicable period during which an action must be commenced; and

WHEREAS, the failure of a local governmental entity to comply with the requirements of RCW 4.96.020 precludes that local governmental entity from raising a defense under RCW 4.96;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the below listed agent is hereby appointed to receive any and all claims for damages made under RCW 4.96 and that this document shall be recorded with the Klickitat County Auditor.


