RESOLUTION NO. 5-2013

A Resolution of the Port of Klickitat Commission
Prohibiting the Production, Processing, and Sale of Marijuana

WHEREAS, the voters of Washington State approved Initiative 502, the provisions of which are codified in Chapter 69.50 Revised Code of Washington (RCW), permitting the production, processing, and retail sale of marijuana; and

WHEREAS, the production, processing, and retail sale of marijuana remains a violation of the federal Controlled Substances Act, the provisions of which are codified in Title 21 United States Code (USC); and

WHEREAS, the lease, rental, or other use of Port buildings, properties, and other facilities in violation of the federal Controlled Substances Act could result in the seizure of same by the United States under the provisions of 21 USC, negatively affect the Port's eligibility to participate in future federal funding opportunities, and constitute a breach of existing agreements entered into between the Port and various agencies of the federal government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Port Commission does hereby prohibit the lease, rental, or other use of its buildings, properties, and other facilities for the cultivation, production, processing, distribution, sale, and/or consumption of marijuana.
